Practice session for bilingual Qurbana at National Convention in Houston, Texas

This was in preparation for the Solemn bilingual Qurbana (English and Syriac) on the second and third days (August 1 and 2, 2019) of the <u>Syro Malabar National Convention in Houston, Texas</u>. The youth choir welcomed the idea of including Syriac chants and made the efforts to learn them in advance. On July 31, we had a final practice. We changed the performance practice the Christological hymn, Sagdinan mar, after the practice. Instead of singing three times on in the same pitch register, we sang in three ascending pitch registers. This was the first time we experimented such practice. Sebastian Ottaplackal accepted my suggestion and prepared the score for the instrumental players on time.
