Lord of all; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, forever.

People: Amen.

Priest: Lord, who may abide in your dwelling, and who may

live on your holy mountain? With pure thoughts, O Lord, let me stand before your altar. Lord, who may abide in your dwelling, and who may live on your

holy mountain?

Server: He who walks without blame, does what is right,

speaks the truth from his heart, and does not slander

with his tongue.

Priest: He who does no evil to his friend and does not

accept a bribe against his neighbor.

Server: He who despises in his sight the wrathful and

honors those who fear the Lord.

Priest: He who swears to his friend, does not lie, and does

not lend his money with interest.

Server: He who does not take a bribe against the innocent.

Whoever does these things is just and shall stand

firm forever.

People: Amen.


